

THINGS THAT YOU NEED TO DO OR KNOW BEFORE
YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING

1. What is your and your family's summer schedule? We need to place you in a week that you are available to do.
2. What week(s) are you going to be a camper?
3. Make sure the camps you pick are eligible for Youth Leaders. (Youth Leaders may help at Elementary camps including Day Camp; they may also help at Adult Special Needs, Mom/Child, and You/Me.
4. Please note that when you complete the training you are only assured of being assigned to one camp.

FORMS

VERY IMPORTANT: Please be sure to fill out the two forms and get them back to us ASAP. This will help us speed up the process of placing everyone for the summer.

- The first form is the **Disclosure Form**. This is a requirement of the State and American Camping Association. You will have to have your parent/guardian co-sign it.
- The second form is the Camp Mechuwana **Youth Leadership Application**

Please also note: Just because you complete the training, you are not guaranteed a placement. The camp leadership may feel that you are not ready for this kind of experience and want to see growth in certain areas before you are placed in a camp. Also, being in good standing with your school and community is very important.
